Task 5

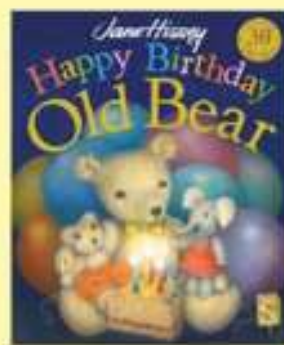
Create a memory jar of your favourite things and memories. This could include favourite toys, pictures, memories from special occasions.
