School Uniform Policy

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We want every member of our school to feel part of the Rivendell Flying High Academy Family. We believe that wearing a smart and practical uniform allows all children to feel equal to their peers and confident in their appearance, giving them a sense of belonging to our school.

Rivendell Flying High Academy is committed to promoting equality and to ensuring that no child is discriminated against due to their religion, belief, economic circumstances or social and cultural background.

Our uniform will promote a sense of pride and act as an identity for all the members of the school, supporting the school's commitment to inclusion.

The uniform has been chosen to be smart, practical and good value for money.

Rivendell Flying High Academy is proud to have high expectations and strives to provide the very best for all our children. All pupils from Nursery through to Year 6 are expected to wear the specified uniform.

Branded items of uniform can be bought online from Kit Out Clothing ([KIT OUT CLOTHING](#)), whilst others are easily available at local shops including supermarkets. A complete list of the items needed for school uniform including those for Physical Education is below.

School Uniform List

- White polo shirt or white blouse/shirt
- Green jumper, sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece (with school logo desirable)
- Black or grey skirt, pinafore dress, trousers or knee length shorts (no cycling shorts). For nursery children only, dark joggers/black leggings can be worn.
- Green and white gingham dress
- Black school shoes. Black trainer type shoes are allowed but must not be 'sports' trainers or branded and should be all black with no coloured/white soles or logos
- Black, grey, or white socks
- Black or grey tights

PE Kit

The PE Kit bags are available from Kit Out Clothing. As a school, we provide all children with one set of a logo PE top, logo PE shorts and socks to ensure that all children wear the correct uniform. Our PE uniform is:

- School Logo PE Kit (top, shorts and socks)
- Plain green or white t-shirt
- Plain green shorts
- Plain green or black jogger bottoms
- Plain green jumper, sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece (no hoodies for health and safety reasons) – this could be your child's school jumper or cardigan
- Plain black or green socks
- Trainers (no football shoes)

On days when pupils have PE, they can come to school in their PE kit. Only the agreed PE Kit above is to be worn, no football tops, shorts or other branded clothing should be worn on PE days. If uniform is not worn, a phone call home to bring the required PE kit for the child to wear will be made.

Other Uniform Information

Jewellery

Children may wear a watch (no smart watches are permitted in school in line with safeguarding arrangements) and a plain pair of gold/silver stud earrings. These must be removed on PE days. No other jewellery is permitted due to health and safety issues and liability in case of loss.

If you would like your child to have their ears pierced, please try to arrange this at the start of the summer holidays so they have enough time to heal. The earrings must be removed so they can participate in PE sessions. Plasters may not be worn to cover earrings. No other piercings are permitted.

Make-up

No make-up, false nails or nail polish to be worn at any time.

Bags

School bags (preferably purchased from Kit Out) should only contain items that the children need for school e.g. home school diary, reading book and homework and bags need to be small enough to be hung on cloakroom pegs. Water bottles are to be kept separately from books to avoid damage as these will need to be replaced.
