Congratulations to Reyyan and Grace who won the competition from the January Rivendell Reader!

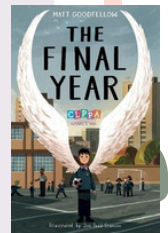
Both children created a brilliant book recommendation and these will be on display in the library for others to see!
